



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

PAAC is committed to provide supplemental scholarship grants to financially challenged graduating high school students who demonstrate outstanding academic achievement, leadership, community involvement and plan to pursue higher education.

APPLICANTS

- Must be single, Filipino citizen, and residing in the Philippines.
- Must be a graduating high school student.
- Must be able to prove his/her financial needs.
- Must have a grade-point average of 85% or better from the previous three years.
- Must be of good moral character.

SCHOLARSHIP GRANT

This scholarship grant is <u>supplemental</u> and does not intend to fully cover all the educational expenses of the students.

This scholarship grant is to be used towards general educational expenses with the priority for tuition. Other allowed uses are for textbooks, school supplies, uniform, student fees, boarding expenses, transportation expenses (to and from school) and other school-related expenses deemed acceptable to the committee.

The scholarship grant amount is Php25,000 per year (or Php12,500 per semester) for four consecutive years in college. It is renewed annually dependent on academic performance, and other criteria to maintain scholarship.

SELECTION PROCESS CRITERIA

Applicants will be evaluated on academic performance, financial need, demonstrated leadership, work ethic, community involvement, and the strength of their essays.

All applications will be reviewed fairly based on criteria, free of lobbying and without regard to ethnicity, region, province of origin, religion, school attended, and planned school.

Upon completion of the selection process, all applicants with be notified of results by email.

The selection process is highly competitive, and we strongly encourage applicants to apply with their best efforts in providing all the requirements, supported by convincing essays.
